The forest service was supportive of the proposal. Nate from F.S. said that the county and forest service are working on a continued maintenance agreement which would become effective after the repair work was completed.	



#### **Goleta Meeting** Dennis Law Dennis and Mark attended. The new F.S. superintendent was introduced, Kevin Elliot. He appears to be focused on forest maintenance, including logging and thinning of the forest. Especially the deceased trees. He is supportive of the CCMA and its efforts. Mt Pinos district is struggling to organize the volunteer groups. Tony Martinez has been made the permanent head of the district. He was the temporary head for the last year or so. The meeting was a joint meeting of motorized and non motorized users. It's interesting to note that the two groups found some common ground in both having similar complaints about the bureaucracy to do needed repairs and expansion of forest usage. **Trail Status** Dennis Law Pozo maintenance There was no Heritage survey done in past years. So we are only allowed to do level one repairs and maintenance until that survey can be done. Level one allows water bar and basin clean out with equipment. It may be done before 5/1 which is the end of the bird nesting season. Bruce has arranged for the student group to return for some hand implement trail work in Mid April. It was decided that we would have two trail maintenance days this month. 3/10 Saturday at 9:00 meet up at Turkey Flats. Bring hand tools for digging. Folding shovels. 3/18 Sunday at 9:00 meet up at Navajo Flats Both days would be to clean out the catch basins and firm up failing water bars. **Poker Run** Hadley Osran The required permits are being applied for. Dennis is going to contact Levi about using the saloon as we have in the past. The new owner was receptive to this use and Levi is event manager. Hadley spoke with Lori from R2R and she has again promised to help with the promotion of the event and the raffle/auction. Our hero, Tom Marcott, has again agreed to promote and run the adventure loop. Last year we had 20 adv guys join us. We also discussed how to advertise the event to a broader group. Cycle news, D37 boards and online were all discussed. Ride reports Carl Brandt Red Rock Ride was sparsely attended. Those that went reported a having a great time. Rode almost 150 miles of desert roads and trails. Explored the Dove Springs area, the Red Rock area, and on Sunday went east to some rocky trails near Randsburg. It was frosty Friday morning with a dusting of snow here and

there. It got warmer as the weekend progressed. Riders reported walking through the entire Burro Schmidt

Tunnel. The food was five star as were the accommodations.
